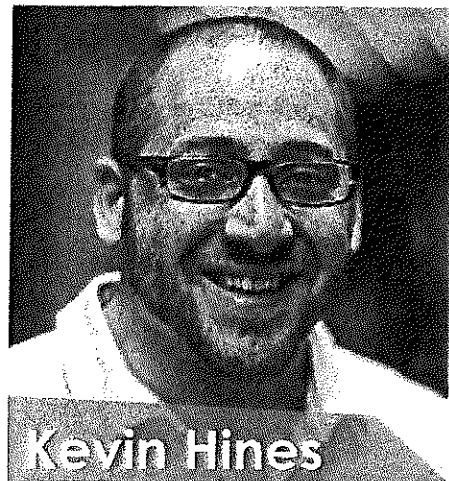
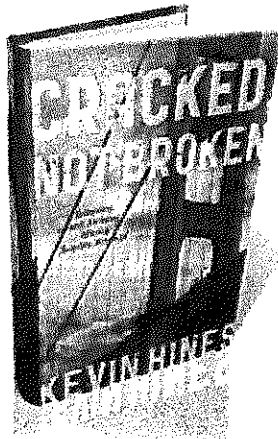


# Suicide Prevention
