Computers and Other Materials:

All computer equipment, cords, books, etc. must be returned to ACE on or before May 31 for summer upgrades, cleaning & inventory.



Internet Bill Reimbursement*:



Bills must be received by the deadline date listed above (also posted on Schoology calendar) and must include:

- Name & address of bill
- dates of service
- actual cost of internet services

Reimbursement is payable to customer name on bill and can repay you up to \$35 of the cost of your monthly internet.



Purchasing a Class:

Summer school classes are available for purchase. ACE students are waived the registration fee for these classes. Call or stop by the office for a form. Summer school classes begin June 2.

Enrollment for 2018-2019:

If you know of someone interested in enrolling for the 2018-2019 school year, have them call the office at 419-738-4572 option 1. Enrollment paperwork will be mailed out in July and must be completed every year for our students. Please plan on attending the correct Orientation date & time for your child's grade level. Orientations will be for student & parent to show you the new programs (Edgenuity & Google Classroom) and how to access grades & progress each week.



County Health Department Required Vaccines Prior to 2018-2019 School Year:

- 7th graders – required to have Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis)
- 7th, 8th, 9th & 12th graders – Meningococcal – 2nd dose requirement if first dose given before age 16.

Students without proof of vaccination will be subject to exclusion from school.

The following are *recommended* vaccines available at health departments for teens:

- Meningitis (MCV4) – 1 or 2 doses depending on age; Most colleges require for those students who live in dorms.
- Pertussis (Whooping Cough: Tdap) – one dose to protect; this can be spread by coughing and sneezing.
- HPV (Human Papillomavirus) – 3 dose series to protect against cervical cancer & genital warts.
- Chicken Pox (Varicella) – 2 doses to protect against if not already immune.
- Hepatitis A - 2 doses to protect against liver disease; spread by close contact and sometimes eating contaminated food or water.
- Influenza – recommended during flu season for everyone 6 months & older.
